1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

3. CITIZEN REQUEST FOR PARTIAL FUNDING TO PURCHASE COQUILLE RIVER WALK BANNERS

Linda Short, 650 S. 1st Ave Coquille, representing Friends of the Coquille River Walk, asked the Urban Renewal Agency to help with the expense of purchasing nine banners for the Riverwalk. The banners were designed by BNT, and there is a picture included in the request. The estimated cost of the nine banners is \$1,579.95, which is good through November 7, 2014. She estimates the total cost to be around \$1800.00, so that knobs can be added to the banner holders and possibly purchase some new brackets. The Friends of the Coquille River Walk will fund \$600, and she has sent a letter to the Port of Bandon requesting \$600. That is set to be on the next agenda. She is requesting \$600 from the URA to finish funding the project. The 30" X 60" banners will be placed from the RV Park to the traffic signal light. Member Heaton asked if this includes the banner holders, and Ms. Short replied that what we have currently will work. Chairman Wiese asked if the holiday banners will be hung, and Ms. Short said yes. The Riverwalk banners will go up after the holiday banners are taken down.

Member Chappelle made motion to award the Friends of the Coquille River Walk a match of up to \$600.00 to purchase river walk banners from BNT. Member Heaton seconded the motion, and all voted in favor.

Member Heaton made a motion to award the Friends of the Coquille River Walk an additional \$600 to purchase river walk banner from BNT if the Port of Bandon does not approve the request. Member Chappelle seconded the motion, and all voted in favor.
