IN A CONTINUING EFFORT TO LIMIT THE SPREAD OF THE COVID-19 VIRUS, COQUILLE CITY HALL & LIBRARY WILL BE CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC, AND OPERATING ON A LIMITED SERVICE BASIS, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, THROUGH MARCH 31st.
(This timeframe will be reevaluated as necessary)

Staff is available by phone and/or email. We understand the inconvenience this may cause; however, for the safety of our patrons and staff, we believe reducing person-to-person interaction is the best way to mitigate the spread of the Coronavirus.

CITY HALL – Utilize the drive-up window for utility payments. You can also utilize the secure payment drop boxes placed throughout the city. Staff checks the boxes daily. Make payments on line at cityofcoquille.org. If you do not have an account, staff can assist you with setting one up. Call in your payment directly to City Hall at 541.396.2115. Use extension 205 to make payments. We recognize the economic hardship that may impact our community during the current public health emergency; therefore, the City is suspending water disconnections and late fees through April 2020.

LIBRARY - Utilize the outdoor book drop to return items; returns will not be accepted inside. This closure time will be used to deep clean and sanitize the library.

PUBLIC WORKS - No public access; staff will continue providing service as usual.

LAW ENFORCEMENT- Coquille Police will be providing local service to the city, as usual. Non-emergency dispatch: 541.269.8911; Dial 911 for emergencies.

OTHER - We have been advised that the Food Bank will maintain their normal operating procedures to continue providing food to those in need. The Community Center is closed to the public through March 2020.
